Last night at 9 o'clock we went to a magic land. There was a false door and an invisible door. Only we knew where the real door was.



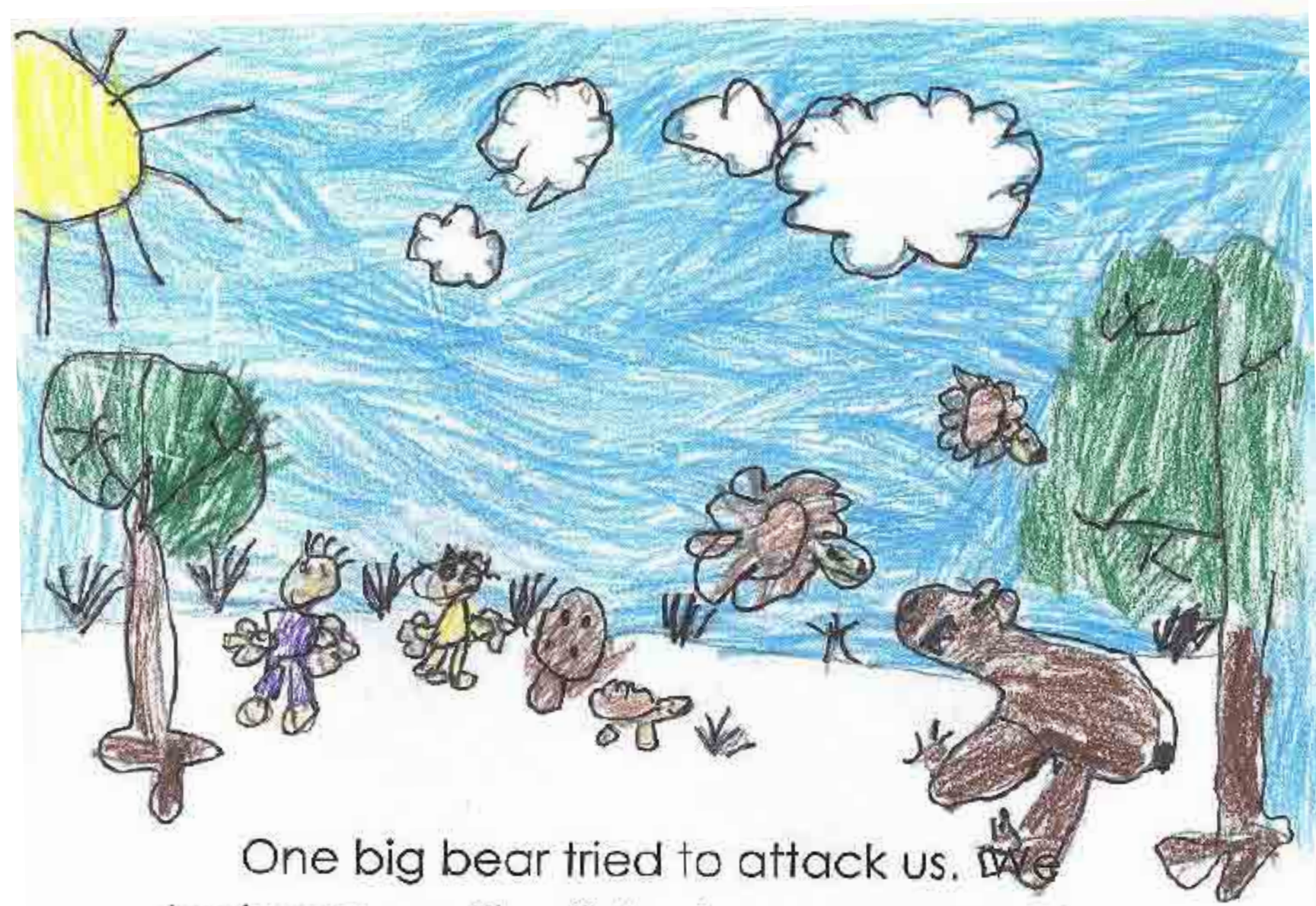
We climbed on the bunk bed and pressed a secret button and climbed up into the ceiling.



There was a big blue Pegasus. The Pegasus took us through a bright tunnel.



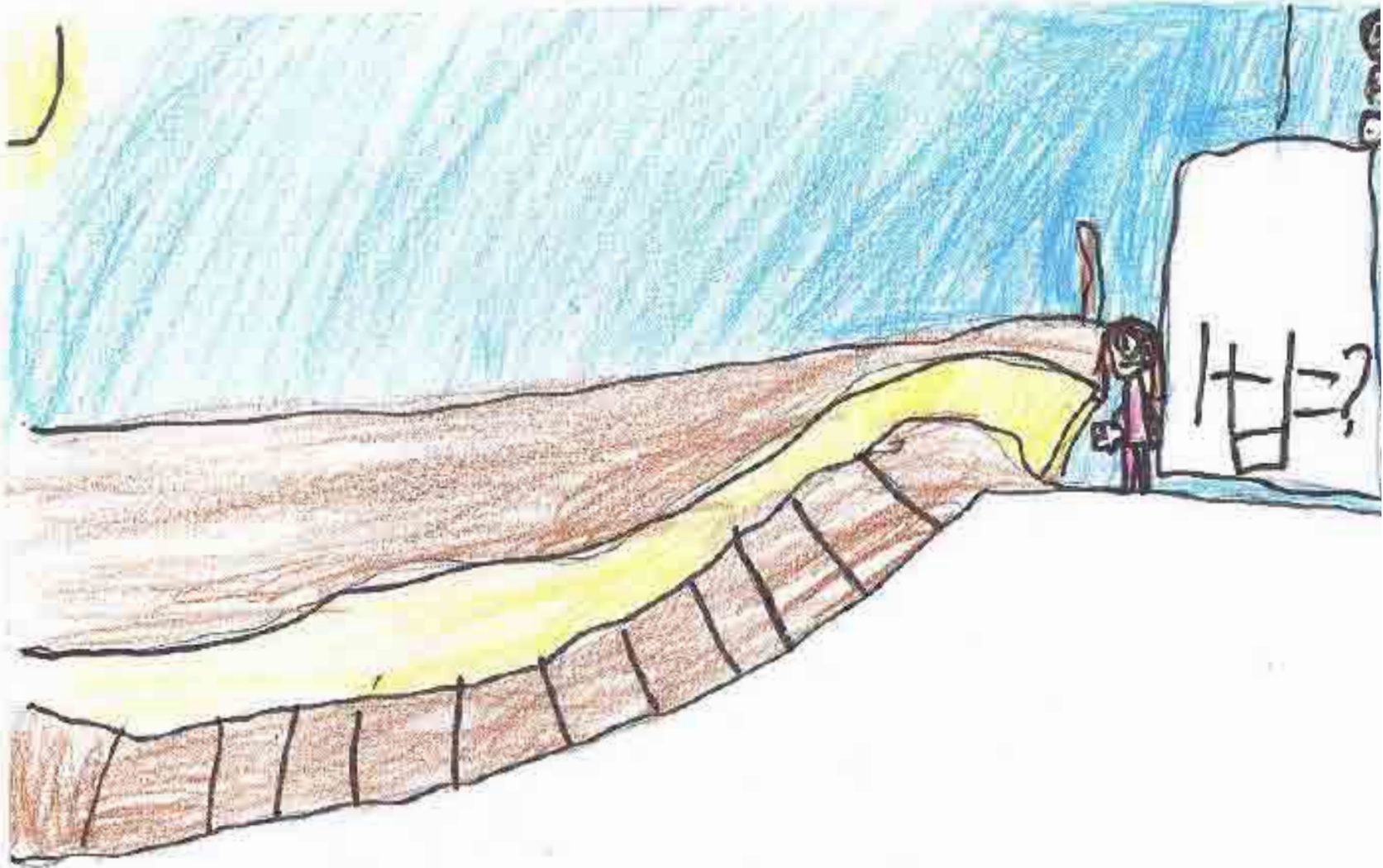
We get to a big forest. It had lots of trees and lots of hedgehogs.



One big bear tried to attack us. We took some quills off the hedgehogs and poked the bear. The hedgehogs threw themselves at the bear and he disappeared.



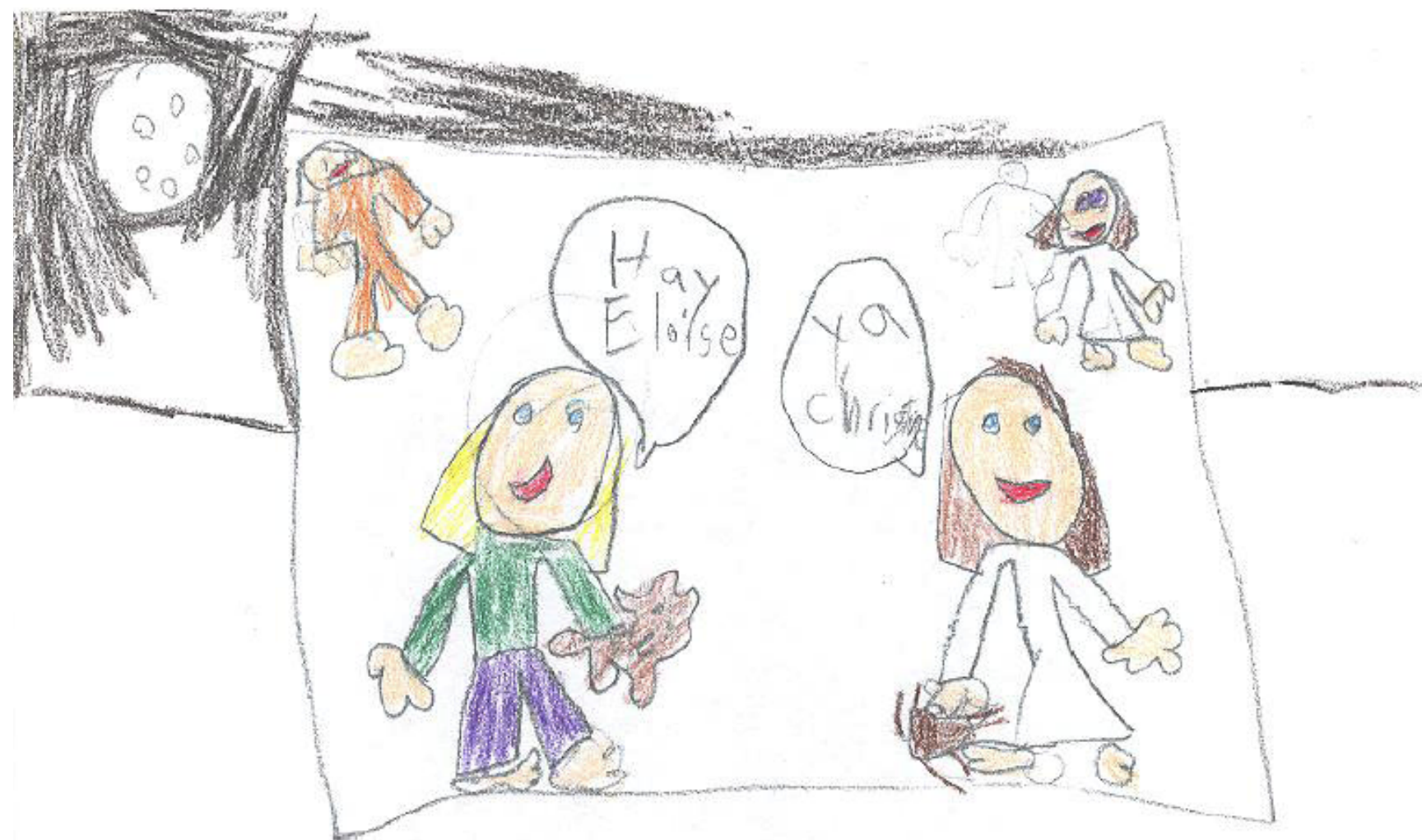
We came to a lake filled with big elephants. We got into some boats and had to row around them.
